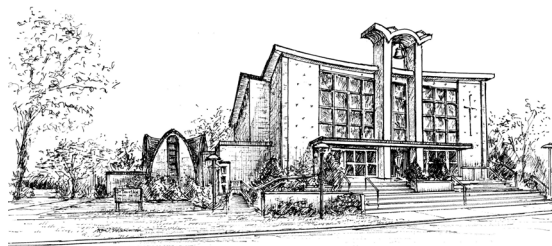

Adult Initiation

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is an ongoing process of individual faith development and communal formation. Anyone interested in learning more about what it means to become a Catholic Christian, should contact the parish office.

Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated at scheduled Liturgies. Parishioners who are expecting a child should contact the office at least two months in advance, or as soon as possible to make arrangements and meet with the Baptismal Preparation Team.

Reconciliation

Also known as “penance” or “confession”, the Sacrament of Penance is regularly available every Saturday at 3:30pm in the church. Individual appointments may also be made with one of the priests. The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated communally during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

Marriage

Engaged parishioners who are interested in being married at St. Timothy Parish must contact one of the priests at least six months in advance. Call the office regarding Marriage Preparation classes.

Sacrament of the Sick

Praying for healing in body, mind and soul has always been a part of the Church’s ministry to those who are ill. Anyone who is seriously ill or anticipating hospitalization, may celebrate the Sacrament on Saturdays following the 9am Mass, or upon request.

Devotion/Prayer Groups

Rosary is said Monday through Saturday prior to morning Mass.

Question of the Week

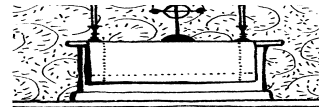
Breaking Open the Word

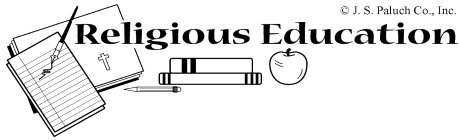

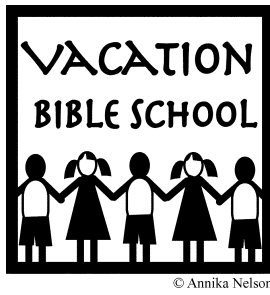

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear friends-

I hope you had a wonderful “start of summer” with the observance of Memorial Day last weekend. Hopefully we all remembered in prayer all those service men and women for whom the Memorial Day observance honors—all those who sacrificed so much so that we could enjoy the gifts of life and liberty. We pray too that those hard earned rights that we have as a country might be used wisely and well by each one of us.

As you know by now, our 5pm Sunday Mass will not be celebrated until the weekend after Labor Day. Attendance at that Mass fluctuates greatly during June, July, and August, and by reducing the number of weekend Masses it gives our hard working lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and musicians a bit of a break (that includes your priests as well). I do hope that we do not see the summer months as a vacation from going to Sunday Mass however. We need to take time each week, and hopefully each day, to be in communion with the Lord—to hear God’s word in the Scriptures and to be nourished with Christ’s Body and Blood. God never takes a vacation away from us, so we should not take a vacation from the Lord.

I am always grateful for the support you give to our parish on a regular basis, and I try not to “harp” about money. There is one need that I would bring to your attention. Each year the proceeds from the Christmas and Easter collections go to assist with the health and retirement needs of the priests of the Archdiocese. That fund suffered great losses over the past few years and was rapidly running out of money.

A great deal of effort has gone into reorganizing those funds and putting them into a much better managed system. This has required some serious changes to this program, as well as a reduction in benefits to many of the priests. Because things were so desperate, desperate measures had to be implemented.

As they say, there are still serious needs to be faced, but there is “light at the end of the tunnel”. The funds are being stabilized and there is hope that things can be turned around. The proceeds from the Christmas and Easter collections are still critical. Last year the Cardinal authorized an additional collection to be taken up in parishes. This collection would also go to the health and retirement fund. He is asking your help again this year by asking you to contribute to a special collection to be held on June 13. There will be envelopes available for this collection prior to that weekend, but I wanted to give you a “heads up” and ask for your help with this important need.
